

# DECATUR GUN CLUB WINGSHOOTING CLINIC

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

1. **DATES AND TIMES:** Sunday, SEPTEMBER 29TH, 2019 - Check-in time 10:30am
2. **LOCATION:** DECATUR GUN CLUB, 61 Faries Park, Decatur, Il. 62526 – 217-877-0400
3. **DIRECTIONS:** On Route 72 Exit 144 Oreana/ Richland Com. College, Turn South on Highway 48, Turn Left on Brush College Road, Turn East off Brush College Road on Rea's Bridge Road & turn South on Christmas Tree Road & follow the road into the Gun Club
4. **Cost:** The fee is **\$10** per person. To secure your reservation, send a check payable to the Decatur Gun Club upon receipt of this instruction sheet. 5. **APPAREL:** Wear upper garments that do not restrict either side-to-side shoulder movement or up and down arm movement. Upper garments should not have snaps, buckles, buttons, or strap adjustments on the front side of the shooting shoulder.
6. **FOOTWEAR:** Wingshooting instruction and shotgun shooting is a field activity. Wear comfortable but sturdy shoes or boots.
7. **EYE & EAR PROTECTION:** **Eye and ear protection are mandatory.** Participants are expected to provide their own shooting glasses and ear plugs or ear muffs. Participants who wear prescription glasses or contact lenses should wear them. Impact resistant safety glasses are required to be worn over prescription glasses if the prescription glasses are not impact resistant. Safety glasses must be worn in addition to contact lenses.
8. **SHOTGUNS & SHOTSHELLS:** Only 28 gauge Shot Guns and Shells will be provided.
9. **INSTRUCTORS:** Wingshooting instruction will be given by National Sporting Clays Association, Certified Wingshooting Instructors.
10. **SPONSORS:** This Wingshooting Clinic is sponsored by a Grant from Friends of the NRA, IL Conservation Foundation & Decatur Gun Club, Decatur Sportsmen Association NFP: in cooperation with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. The IDNR & NRA have been involved in training sportsmen and women through its Safety Education Section, by sponsoring wingshooting clinics, through youth hunting programs, and through hunters' skills programs for many years.
